	Complete the <u>Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)</u> . The priority filing deadline date is March 1 . You do not have to wait to be admitted: completing the FAFSA simultaneously with the admission process allows for a seamless financial aid process. Northeastern Code: 002199

Documents may include: Federal Student Loan Entrance Counseling, Master Promissory Note (MPN), Northeastern Title IV Credit Authorization, and possibly a Self-Certification Form. You may review your financial aid status via your myNortheastern portal. Once you have logged in, choose "Services & Links" and select "My Financial Aid Status."
