- Respond promptly to any request for additional documentation. You will be notified via email to your Husky account if additional documentation is required.
- Admitted students will be notified electronically of their financial aid award based on the registration period for the term of entry.
- Review your award. Contact your [financial aid counselor](#) if your enrollment plans change or if you wish to cancel or reduce a portion of your financial aid.
- Complete the necessary loan documentation (if accepting loans). Documents may include Federal Student Loan Entrance Counseling, Master Promissory Note (MPN), and Title IV Credit Authorization. Additional information regarding [loan documents](#) is available online and will be included in your offer of financial assistance.
- Secure [financing options](#), i.e., supplemental and private loans, or enroll in the monthly payment plan by the due date.
