



New students, don't forget to check your e-bill! You will be notified at your Northeastern e-mail address whenever an online bill is generated. You can then log into your myNortheastern and click on the "NUPay" link. In the "Your Bills" box on the right, click "View" next to the date of the bill you wish to access.

5. The drop-down menu on your My Financial Aid Status will serve as your primary navigation. Please note that the options within the menu will change depending on the time of year and where you are in the financial aid application process. Options within the menu include:
- Applications:** provides access to online loan acceptance forms, enrollment change forms, and other financial aid applications that may be requested by our office.
  - Documents & Messages:** provides information regarding requested financial aid documents and the status of those materials. Here, you can also find important messages related to those documents.
  - Awards:** provides information regarding your current financial aid award, including the type of financial aid offered and amount.



- Documents & Messages:** the document view provides information about the document, including the document name, status, and date that the status was last updated. Here, you can also access many commonly requested forms by clicking on the hyperlinked text, in red.

The document status that you may see here include:

- Not Received:** indicates that the document has not been received by Student Financial Services.
- Not Reviewed:** indicates that the document has been received and is currently under review by Student Financial Services.
- Received:** indicates that the item has been received and reviewed by Student Financial Services.

7. **Awards:** students who have been awarded financial aid for a given academic year will see the “Awards” item under the drop-down menu. Within the “Awards” page, your award is broken up by the total award, but also by the type of financial aid—grants and scholarships, loans, and Federal Work-Study.

Please note that if you have been awarded a Federal Direct Subsidized and/or Unsubsidized Loan, the amount(s) reflected on this page are the “gross” amount, rather than the “net” amount. The gross loan amount does not take into account origination fees, which are deducted from each loan disbursement.
