- Secure financing options, such as supplemental loans, or enroll in the monthly payment plan by the due date.
- Awards will be available during the summer. Once your award is available, you will be notified at your Northeastern email address and directed to view your award in your [Student Hub](#).
- Check your Northeastern email and e-bills regularly so that you do not miss critical information.
- Review your award. Contact our office if your enrollment plans change or if you wish to cancel or reduce a portion of your financial aid.
