Complete the <u>Free Application for Federal Student Aid</u> (<u>FAFSA</u>). The priority filing deadline date is **March 1**. You do not have to wait to be admitted; completing the FAFSA simultaneously with the admission process allows for a seamless financial aid process.

- Respond promptly to any request for additional documentation. You will be notified via email to your Northeastern account if additional documentation is required.
- Financial aid awards are available beginning in July. You will be notified via email to your Northeastern account once your award is available.
- Review your award. Contact our office if your enrollment plans change or if you wish to cancel or reduce a portion of your financial aid.

Complete the necessary loan documentation (if accepting loans). Documents may include Federal Student Loan Entrance Counseling, Master Promissory Note, Title IV Credit Authorization, and possibly a Self-Certification Form. You may review your financial aid status on your Student Hub.

- Secure financing options, such as supplemental loans, or enroll in the monthly payment plan by the due date.
- Check your Northeastern email and e-bills regularly so that you do not miss critical information.
