2026-2027 Verification of Identity

If a student is unable to appear in person at Northeastern University to verify his or her identity, the student must appear in person in front of a notary and provide to the institution:

- Identity Verification Notary Certification - must be completed in person with a notary; and
- A copy of a valid, unexpired, government-issued photo identification that is acknowledged in the notary certification below, or that is presented in person to a notary, such as, but not limited to:
 - Driver's license
 - Other state-issued ID
 - Passport

Instruction to notary: If the notary certification uses a separate form, it must include a description of the valid, unexpired government-issued photo ID presented in person to the notary.
